

CHRISTMAS EVE IN RINGWOOD MARKET **PLACE 2023 Carols and Santa**

THE Rotary Club of Ringwood has been organising an event in Ringwood which as far as we know is unique in this country.

We organise a carol concert complete with a Santas Grotto, in the Market Place in Ringwood

but with a twist. Instead of the children who attend receiving gifts they give father Christmas a gift which is then passed on to local Childrens Homes and Special Schools.

The Ringwood Rotary Club took over and has been organising it since 1999. Some changes have been made over the years and it has now evolved into an event that the town just assumes will happen, so very little publicity is required. Even Covid did not disrupt the event for long. The event is still supported by a number of companies, Particularly Abacus who lend us the lorry for the grotto and Ringwood Town Council for financial support and equipment and other groups and individuals who help on the night and Ringwood and Fordingbridge news for the carols published in the local paper.

The main feature to the event is always our Reindeer and Sleigh which is now about 75 years old and which forms the centre piece for the event.

The event is also supported by the Town Council and by local churches and community groups who provide us with essential parts of our celebrations. In particular we have our music provided by the combined Salvation Army and The Ringwood and Burley Band who have a long-term commitment with the event. Every year about 3000 people attend.

Many of the parents that bring their children to the Market Place on Christmas Eve where themselves brought there by their own parents or grandparents.

The special part to the event is the presents that are given by the children attending and we collected 600 last year, and the thanks the children receive from Father Christmas which makes a

The other part of the event that generally goes unreported is the meeting up of friends and families at this special time of the year. There are usually groups of people going off to continue the celebrations after the event is over, as a prelude to Christmas.

This is not promoted as a religious event even if the local churches are involved. We also have our mayor and of course Father Christmas who have a Christmas message. The final blessing is more a thank you and an invitation to see you next year and to have a Very Merry Christmas.

Ringwood Society Design and Conservation Awards

RINGWOOD Society was delighted to present its Design and Conservation Awards on 18th October 2023, with three awards being presented by Town Deputy Mayor and Ringwood Society Committee member, Rae Frederick.

The award for Best Residential Project went to Emily and Joe Sturdy for Orchard House, an excellent example of a thoughtful and thorough restoration. Inappropriate paint and poor-quality modifications have been removed, and new timber sash windows have been installed.

On receiving the award Emily said "We are so proud of our new home. It's been a long road to get it to where it is now. It's been great uncovering some of its old features and adding some new things too. We are excited for our future at Orchard House and glad we've been able to revive it."

Best Commercial Project was won by The Pour House. Pictured receiving the award are Tina Saddington and Simon Jeanes. Ringwood Social Club closed its doors in 2011, and after 12 years of hard work the building is open and returned to its former glory. This is testament to the determination and drive of Tina Saddington and Helen Homewood.

Helen commented that "it was a wonderful surprise to be a recipient and to have the committee's hard work and dedication recognised. We hope that The Pour House goes on to be a longstanding integral part of the wonderful community that makes up Ringwood."

And the winners of Best Community Project were St. Peter

and St. Paul Church, South Window Restoration. Pictured are Jacqueline Brown and Roger Dewar from Ringwood Benefice and Emma Mullen of St Ann's Gate Architects receiving their awards.

After nearly 200 years of weathering the South window stonework had deteriorated to such a degree that the glass was in serious danger of falling out.

Emma Mullen said "The urgent need to make the south elevation structurally sound and watertight provided an exciting and rare opportunity as church architect, to design a new window. The contemporary and simple design sought to enhance that which it replaced; introducing coloured glass and motifs inspired by the New Forest, whilst working within a traditional diamond leaded matrix. It was a pleasure to work with the Parish Church and the experts at Salisbury Cathedral Stained Glass and Colin Avery stonemasons on the successful delivery of this project."

Jacqueline Brown added "The Parish Church is absolutely delighted to receive this recognition from the Ringwood Society. This was a long and at times arduous project and so we are even more thrilled with the result, and with the number of people from the town who have engaged with it and sponsored panes of glass. It's good to know that the church is now weathertight for the next hundred years!"

Alex Bancroft from the Ringwood Society Committee explained, "All our winners show the desire and drive to restore and bring back to life buildings of historic importance within the town. Our awards aim to recognise the thought, attention to detail and efforts of those involved. Nominations are now open for the Design and Conservation Awards for 2024"

NEWS Could you help toads cross a busy road?

WHEN the local toads start thinking in January about migrating down to Blashford Lakes to breed and lay their eggs, the Ringwood and Poulner Toad Patrol will be helping them safely across the road.

Registered with the wildlife charity Froglife who coordinate toad patrolling throughout the UK, the patrol is looking for new. volunteers to save the toads from being killed under the wheels of cars and vans, and asking local drivers to help by slowing down and being patient. Set up in 1989 and organised for 35 years by wildlife supporter Teresa Baker, the patrol is now run by Nicola Yorke – volunteer since the 2021 season.

"It's a great honour to have been asked by Teresa to take over our friendly, inclusive group and carry on her great work" said Nicola. "Common toads are declining across the UK and face huge dangers as they crawl across busy roads. We're always looking for more willing volunteers who can spare a couple of hours one evening a week. And we'd be really grateful if more drivers slowed down and kept an eye out for toads on the short stretch of road we patrol from the North Poulner crossroads up to Rockford Common. It would make an enormous difference and many more precious lives would be saved."

At the start of the breeding season in mid to late January, male and female toads crawl down from the wooded hills above Blashford Lakes to find a mate and breed. By early Spring after their eggs are laid they make the return journey, once again facing the dangers of the busy road.

"Toads only move when it's warm enough" said Nicola – "five degrees and above. Wet nights are perfect but they'll also cross when it's not raining, particularly in the beginning when they're keen to get down to the lake.


"As soon as the breeding season starts, our volunteers take turns to drive slowly along the road from dusk until 11pm, stopping to pick up toads and carry them across the road so they can safely continue their journey down to the water." Understanding Investments-Reflections on 2023



FOLLOWING a very difficult 2022, 2023 has continued to be challenging for many of the same reasons.

-Geo-Political concerns continue following Russia's invasion of Ukraine along with the more recent attack on Israel and their subsequent retaliation.

-Inflation has proved harder to bring down so interest rates have gone up more than originally forecast.

These two factors have continued to negatively impact investment returns, albeit less dramatically than in 2022. At least cash returns have been attractive in the shorter-term.

And that's an important point-"shorter-term". When investing it is really important to be forward-looking and not make decisions based on looking backwards or on emotions. It's quite typical right now for investors (especially inexperienced investors who may have only invested during the past few years) to feel as though cash is the best place to be and to feel frustrated by the lower or negative investment returns of the past 2 years.

Oh and don't forget the extreme volatility during the COVID pandemic of 2020. It's certainly been a tough period for investors.

It's good news for savers that cash can now offer a better return than it has done for the past 15 years. But if this economic cycle is anything like others (they usually are), then as the effects of higher interest rates start to be felt by the consumer, the property market and companies with higher levels of debt, the central banks will then commence more stimulus and lower rates again (unlikely to be back to the historical lows post-2008 but "normalized rates" could be circa 3% to 4%). So we might then expect cash returns to be lower than they are today.

If interest rates settle at current levels, the valuations on fixed interest investments and equities look attractive. If interest rates fall, then these become even more attractive. In fact JP Morgan predict the future returns on a 60%/40% Equity/Bond portfolio for the next 10 years could average 7% per annum which is 1% higher than the average over the past 25 years vs cash returns of 2.9% per annum. Of course these are only predictions and are not guaranteed, but my 35 years of investing experience tells me that when investors lose patience, they usually make the wrong decisions (often selling low and buying high!). The role we play as investment advisers is to help clients zone out their emotions, zone out the news noise and think rationally. Having been through the pain of the past 2 years and with valuations

more attractive, now is not the time to lose patience. Economic cycles change, it's just no-one knows exactly when! Keep sufficient cash for the short-term (3 to 5 years) and hold your nerve with high-quality investments for the longer term.

Separately, a quick update on some developments at our Ringwood office. We have expanded and taken over the unit next door so we look forward to welcoming existing and new clients to our comfortable premises. There are now 3 financial advisers supported by two administrators. Maintaining a local office presence is really important as it keeps us accessible to our clients. It's expensive for us (which is why other financial institutions are closing theirs) but illustrates our commitment to providing the best service possible. On that note, we won the inaugural Ringwood Business Awards "Excellence in Customer Service" award. We also continue to receive great client feedback online via Google Reviewsplease take a look as they do give you a feel for our client's experience.

Finally, we will be making a Christmas donation to a local charity again, as we did last year, in lieu of a client gift.


