





Work on Ringwood Almshouses Roof and Chimneys Nears Completion



The Ringwood Almshouses situated on the corner of the Quomp and School Lane provide accommodation for Ringwood residents who have reached a certain age, are vulnerable, or are otherwise in need of accommodation.


Ringwood United Charities looks after the building and cares for the welfare of the residents who live there. Work, costing around £100,000 to restore the chimneys and roof is almost complete. Indeed, the restoration of the chimneys won a conservation award from Ringwood Society in 2022.

> Dave Brown, Chair of the Trustees said 'We are delighted with the result of the restoration work and the benefit the new roof will bring to residents. Given the listed status of the building it would be fair to say it has, at times, been a challenging project. Next we plan to update the heating system to further improve the comfort of those who live there."

The Charity is supported by donations and run by a group of volunteer trustees alongside a part-time Clerk who manages the day-to-day running of the Almshouses and looks after the wellbeing of the residents.

Dave added "Unfortunately we are currently without a Clerk, this is such a vital role for us and the residents and we really hope to fill the position soon."

County debut for Ringwood Darts player

Local darts player Henry Shutler played his first game for Dorset in UK Darts Association National League Premiership when they travelled to South Wales to play Glamorgan.

Henry plays for The Railway in the Ringwood League and the St Ives based Alderholt in the Dorset Superleague. He has also played for Furlong Badgers in the Fordingbridge League. His consistent form in the Superleague drew the attention of the county selectors who invited him to join the squad. Although named as a reserve for the Glamorgan trip, a late withdrawal gave him his opportunity. County games are played over two days with the B teams (6 ladies and 12 men)playing on Saturdays and the A teams in action on Sundays. Each win is worth one point with three bonus points going to the overall winner (one point each in the event of a draw). Dorset are playing at the highest level of county darts for the first time this season.

Henry was drawn to play the penultimate game of the first day and after a number of matches had gone to the deciding seventh leg, the game was tied at 8-8. With the score at two legs each, Henry threw a 15 dart leg with a 110 check out. This was matched by his opponent to take the game to a deciding leg. The Glamorgan player seemed to have the edge but with a 122 check out with a bull finish, Henry took the point.

Dorset led 10-8 at the end of the first day.

The ladies A team suffered a heavy defeat but the situation was recovered by the men's A team, including 2015 world champion Scott Mitchell and former Furlong PUCS player Robbie Martin,




which won 8-4 to give Dorset a 19-17 win.

The next county game is over the first weekend of March when Yorkshire, one of the big guns of the National League, visit Dorset.

In the Superleague, Alderholt are currently in third position but will face champions Hamworthy in their next home game on 24th February.

New Forest District Council to review its Local Plan

At their Cabinet meeting today, Wednesday 7 February 2024, New Forest District Council(NFDC) moved ahead with a recommendation to Council that work commences on a formal review of its Local Plan.

As well as setting a vision for the future of the area, a Local Plan sets a strategy for how, when and where needs of the community will be met, including the imperative issue of addressing housing needs, and provides policies to address specific matters. Once adopted the Local Plan provides the basis upon which future development proposals are assessed against.

Over the coming months, the Council will be engaging with communities and infrastructure providers across the New Forest to identify the issues that the Local Plan Review should address.

Since the Council's most recent Local Plan was adopted in 2020, there have been several significant changes which a new Local Plan will look to address. These include lower than expected housing delivery, the Council's climate change and nature emergency declaration in 2021 and the opportunities from the designation of sites across the Waterside as part of the Solent Freeport.

Councillor Derek Tipp, Portfolio Holder for Planning and Economy said:

"Now is an ideal time for us to be moving forward with reviewing our Local Plan to support a prosperous and thriving place

for our residents and businesses. We will be engaging with people who live and work in the area, as well as our partners in the community, to help inform our review. I urge residents to get involved and have their say to help shape our plans."

Following expected ratification at the full meeting of the Council

on 26 February, work will formally commence to identify the issues that the Local Plan should address. This information will be formed into a draft version of the Local Plan which is expected to be formally consulted upon next year.

Bournemouth Heart Club - no longer just for hearts

"Get Well, Feel Well, Keep Well" is the message being promoted by the Bournemouth Heart Club (BHC) to people living in East Dorset and West Hampshire suffering from serious health conditions.

One of only a few specialist exercise facilities in the UK, the heart club has been a centre of excellence in cardiac rehabilitation since 1996. However, following the pandemic, BHC has developed its Keep Well hub to specifically provide exercise classes for people with other types of health conditions such as Type 2 diabetes, stroke (TIA), claudication, respiratory disease (COPD) and obesity.

Currently the club is working in partnership with the University Hospitals Dorset (UHD) Diabetes Centre to run a year long series of exercise and education courses called 'Refocusise' for people living with Type 2 diabetes.

Funded by NHS Dorset, these courses require patients to be referred by their practice nurse or diabetes clinician, but for other medical conditions patients can self-refer directly to the heart club. A typical Keep Well programme includes an initial health and fitness assessment; a bespoke 20-session exercise course over 10 weeks and an end of course review to highlight on-going areas for improvement.

The Bournemouth Heart Club is a purpose built facility with two fully equipped gymnasiums, and a member's car park in the grounds of Royal Bournemouth Hospital. Open 6 days a week the heart club operates a full timetable of group exercise classes, circuit classes, open gym, seated and zoom classes. Its members are as young as twenty and as old as ninety, but all have the same aim, to improve their physical health and mental wellbeing.

Olivia Bailey, operations manager of the Bournemouth Heart Club emphasised the major benefit. "All of our instructors hold the BACPR Level 4 qualification which is the gold standard in cardiac rehabilitation so our members can exercise safely within the limits of their medical condition".

Flydressers Guild

Flydressers Guild chose Greyfriars as their new home, from January this year! Fly dressing, also known as fly tying, is the craft of constructing an artificial lure to represent an insect, fish or other food eaten mainly by trout, salmon and other predatory species, for fishing purposes.

The traditional methods use fur and feather from many different species. The craft dates back to Roman times but seems to have experienced its biggest period of growth in the 1850s. This branch was established soon after the formation of the Flydressers Guild and has held regular meetings ever since its foundation in 1968 and has continued to attract a loyal following, with a current membership of around 50.

They meet weekly between September and April and offer a structured course of instruction through 3 groups: Beginners, Improvers 1 and Improvers 2 after which several options are open for members to pursue their own particular interest. Opportunity is also given for members to take part in the Guild's awards programme. The evenings are informal affairs lasting around an hour and a half with refreshments being served during the meeting.

New Forest District Council begins trial of new CCTV cameras in Fordingbridge as part of commitment to maintain low crime in rural communities

New Forest District Council (NFDC) has begun a trial of new CCTV camera technology in Fordingbridge. This forms part of the council's commitment to maintaining low crime levels in rural communities.

Working in partnership with Fordingbridge Town Council, the camera was installed in Fordingbridge high street for a period of 4 weeks for testing. The new 4G cameras produce high-definition images in colour and have integrated infra-red to enhance images at nighttime and in low light conditions.

During the trial period, the council will test the functionality of the cameras and quality of the footage. The council will continue to engage with the local business community and residents to gain feedback.

Residents interested in learning more about the trial are invited to attend an

event hosted by New Forest District Council and Fordingbridge Town Council. The event will be on Thursday 22 February at 6pm in Fordingbridge Town Hall. This will provide an opportunity for the council to share their findings about the project and answer any questions from residents and people from the local business community.

Cllr Dan Poole, Portfolio Holder for Community, Safety and Wellbeing, said:

"The trial of new CCTV camera technology in Fordingbridge marks a significant step forward in our efforts to continue maintaining a secure environment for our community, fostering a sense of confidence and wellbeing for all our residents.

I'm delighted with how the trial is going so far and urge residents of the area to attend the community event on 22 February to find out more. I would like to thank Fordingbridge Town Council for their support with this vital project."

Fordingbridge was selected for the trial as it currently doesn't have any CCTV cameras. If the trial is successful, the council will look to expand the CCTV

network across other areas of the district that do not currently have cameras, including Fawley, Brockenhurst and Bransgore.

The new camera roll-out over the next 2 years comes as part of the council's continued commitment to supporting their communities by helping residents feel safe. The £300,000 investment into the expansion of the district's CCTV network includes additional funding from the Home Office Safer Streets Fund with a focus on rural communities.


