

Understanding Investments: Investment choices within a Pension

For many people, pension savings may be their most significant asset other than their house. Yet I often find people don't know what they are invested in, let alone understand the investment choices available to them. Making the right choices can have a significant effect on the size of your future retirement fund.

When joining a pension scheme, you are often placed into the scheme's default investment funds. These are usually Lifestyled to the scheme's Normal Retirement Date (NRD), for example age 67 (but could be between 60 and 67). Your money is then invested in growth assets (usually shares) in the early years with the aim of offering a higher return, albeit with more volatility. The logic is that volatility is less important at this stage as there are many years to go before the money is required so if the fund suffers a fall in value there is time for it to recover.

As the NRD draws closer (for example 10 years away), Lifestyling will automatically start to switch a percentage of the money into lower risk assets (perhaps a balanced fund investing in a mix of shares and bonds or a low risk fund investing in bonds or cash). The logic being that as you get closer to retirement your pension becomes less volatile as you have less time to recover from stock market declines. For many this is a sensible approach and aims to help manage risk without any effort required by the pension plan member. But there are pitfalls:

1 - Lifestyling can vary between schemes so understanding how your own pension scheme operates is important.

2 - There can be different Lifestyled target outcomes. For example, some will target the purchase of an annuity at the Normal Retirement Date so the asset allocation will be more defensive and result in 75% invested in bonds and 25% in cash at the NRD. Other's may target drawdown so will be more balanced and perhaps end up with 75% in a medium risk balanced fund and 25% in cash.

3 - What if you plan on retiring before the pension scheme's NRD?The investments will likely be unbalanced and not reflective of your plans which may lead to unnecessary risk.

There are alternative choices.

Most schemes will offer a range of funds from which you can "self-select". By doing so you may be able to better bespoke your pension plan to your own retirement plans. However, selecting the right funds, and the subsequent returns earned from those funds, will affect the final value of your retirement pot so this is not recommended unless you are a very experienced investor or you take professional financial advice.

There are even pension plans available which can offer temporary annuities and therefore remove investment risk. The annuity can be taken as income or rolled up within the pension and therefore offers a guaranteed future value. The rates on these plans have increased over the past 18 months as interest rates (and therefore annuity rates) have risen. These can be very attractive for clients under 5 years from retirement or for more cautious investors.

In conclusion, if your pension is a significant part of your overall wealth and therefore critical to your future retirement plans, treat it as such and give it the attention it deserves. Pension planning can be complex, so seeking advice from suitably qualified professional advisers is recommended.

Loved ones gain invaluable insights into living with dementia at St Ives House care home

A dedicated dementia information session was held for the relatives of residents at St Ives care home in Ringwood.

The session was led by Karen Hodges, Group Dementia Lead for Care South, the not-for-profit charity which runs the care home on Horton Road.

Karen spoke about the symptoms that a person living with dementia may experience, along with an explanation of the changes in the brain responsible for language and communication can be affected. She then explained to the loved ones of the care home residents how people can adapt their own language and communication to continue having meaningful interactions with their loved ones.

We often hear that their relatives are looking to educate themselves on how best to help their loved ones, so we responded to this by hosted a session to suggest some subtle changes they can make to engage with their relative. 

It was kicked to the corner seven meters out, so it was time for Ellingham to pull out their highly effective maul. Tottonians did a great job of defending it, with the maul collapsing a couple of meters short, but Will Tunnicliff picked up from the back and crashed over the line for Ellingham's second try, but on this occasion Serle was unable to kick the conversion.

Ellingham found themselves back in the Tottonians half with a penalty for a high tackle. They took it quickly spinning it to the right, and after a quick ruck it came back the other way with Robert Clitheroe making a great run into the heart of the Tottonians defence, sucking in defenders. An offload to Kian Jenkins allowed him to crash through the Tottonians tacklers for the try, which Serle converted. There was still time for one final score before half time. Tottonians had a scrum on their own 22 metre line and looked to clear their lines with a kick, but unfortunately it landed in the hands of Archie Winterburn, who carried straight back into the Tottonians defenders. From the resulting ruck, the ball was spun to the right and Oli Hind made a lovely arcing run, breaking at least five tackle before touching down, but unfortunately Serle was unable to add the conversion, which meant Ellingham led 24-3 at the break.

Ellingham kicked off the second half up the hill and while they had a big lead it felt like the first five minutes would be important, as they were now playing up the significant slope and into the wind. There was a lineout 7seven meters from the Tottonians line, which Ellingham won, followed by a few carries into the Tottonians defence. Play then became scrapy with multiple turn overs and charged down kicks, before Ellingham were able to spin the ball to the right and Oli Hind, now with a taste for the try line, broke more tackles and crashed over for another try, but the conversion was missed. The next try came from a strong defensive effort. Tottonians were on



the attack and a strong ruck clearance, near the right hand touchline meant Ellingham turned the ball over. Will Tunnicliff picked up and spun it left and Ellingham, playing heads up rugby, noticed that the Tottonians defence was disorganised, so they managed to put Freddie Serle through a gap and he was able to run in from the half way line, scoring and converting his own try.

At this point Ellingham lost a little focus and Tottonians made the most of this, They carried hard into the Ellingham defence and won a penalty.

Taking this quickly, they were able to force penalty after penalty, keeping Ellingham on the back foot. There was then a brief pause for a shoulder injury to a Tottonians player. When the game restarted excellent tackling kept Tottonians from scoring, but eventually the pressure told. Tottonians span the ball to the right to their strongest ball carrier and he ran past a number of Ellingham defenders and scored in the corner. Ellingham wanted to end the game on a high, so they worked their way up the pitch and were awarded a scrum on the five metre line. Dylan Powell picked up from Number 8 and carried hard, but was stopped just short of the try line. The ball was recycled and a couple of good phases took place before Oli Hind was able to pick up from the back of a ruck and charge over for his hat-trick try, which Freddie Serle converted.




