Ringwood to start its own Repair Café

What do you do with a broken toaster? Or with a bike when the wheel runs out of true? Or with a jumper full of moth holes? Bin it? No way!

Greening Ringwood is organising Ringwood's first Repair Café event on Saturday 27th April at the town's Greyfriars Community Centre.

Starting at 10am (until 12noon), a number of volunteer repair experts will be available to help make all possible repairs (one item per customer) free of charge. Tools and materials will also be on hand.

People visiting the Repair Café are encouraged to bring along broken items from home. Toasters, lamps, hair dryers, clothes, bikes, toys, crockery... anything that is broken is welcome. And can more than likely be repaired. The Repair Café specialists almost always have the know-how.

By promoting repairs, Greening Ringwood aims to help reduce mountains of waste. This is absolutely necessary, according to Lindsay Andrews, Greening Ringwood's Co-ordinator. "We throw away piles of stuff in the UK. Even things which have practically nothing wrong with them, and yet could easily

be used again after a simple repair. Unfortunately, many people have forgotten that they (continue p.4)



Let It Bee: NFDC plans to relax grass cutting in May



New Forest District Council (NFDC) has announced plans to let the grass grow longer this spring.

In May and parts of June, grass will be left to grow, rather than being mowed, on some verges and larger patches of land in the district.

NFDC's 'Let It Bee' approach to grass cutting will increase the number of plant species, nectar sources for pollinators, and habitats for wildlife.

The council took part in 'No Mow May' last year; a campaign to encourage people to not mow their lawns in the month of May and to mow less during the summer.

NFDC is now calling their 2024 approach 'Let It Bee' to highlight the importance of bees as pollinators and letting grass grow for wildlife.

Cllr Geoffrey Blunden, portfolio holder for environment and sustainability, said:

"We're looking forward to seeing areas in our district flourish with our 'Let It Bee' approach."

"We have listened to feedback from last year and are working closely with Hampshire County Council to make sure grass will be cut where it is important for safety and visibility."

"We'll be continuing to review sites that might work for wildflower planting and use information gained from our trial sites at Fawley Fields and Appletree Court to help with this."

"We'd like to encourage residents to consider having their own wild areas in their gardens. You can reduce grass cutting at the bottom of your hedge to encourage more species to grow naturally or pick up wildflower mixes from your local seed retailer for your garden or window boxes."

Repair Café is also intended to put townsfolk in touch with each other in a new way. And to discover that a lot of know-how and practical skills can already be found in the local community.







Ringwood & Fordingbridge Footpath Society Celebrate 50th Anniversary

Ringwood & Fordingbridge Footpath Society

S 2024 is the 50th anniversary of The Ringwood and Fordingbridge Footpath Society (RFFS). RFFS was formed in 1974 to protect the interests of users of public paths by ensuring (a) their reasonable maintenance and freedom from obstruction and (b) their adequate signposting and waymarking.

It aims to urge local authorities to discharge their responsibilities with regard to public paths and seeks to foster and maintain friendly cooperation between path users, landowners, local authorities and the community generally. We participate with Councils in surveying, improving and maintaining local paths and devising healthy walks and many other circular walking routes which are published in leaflet form.

The Society's area is made up of thirteen parishes and covers about 160 square kilometres of greatly varied countryside ranging from quiet water meadows to high wind-blown common, from the edge of the New Forest to the borders of Cranborne Chase. A variety of flora and fauna including deer may be seen and within the New Forest, grazing ponies, cattle, donkeys, sheep and pigs may be met. Although we are essentially a footpath protection organisation, we believe that the best way of maintaining the network in good order is to make good and regular use of it.

The Society provides a comprehensive programme of guided walks and social events throughout the year that are published in "Waymark", the quarterly magazine that is available on our website, www.rffs.org.uk. We also have a Facebook page to keep up with society walks & updates.



Newcomers to the area, prospective new members and visitors are very welcome to join us for walks in these delightfully varied parts of Hampshire, Dorset and Wiltshire. Many of our walks take place on the rights of way in our 13 parishes in an area of wonderfully contrasting scenery, from the New Forest to the rolling chalk downlands. We also venture to other areas such as the coastline of Dorset and the rural landscapes of southern Wiltshire, Dorset and Hampshire.



Augustus John Talk, Brilliant Destiny


Augustus John, one of Fordingbridge's most notorious past residents will be the subject of a talk organised by Fordingbridge Museum on Friday 26th April. His unconventional and bohemian lifestyle dismayed some locals when he lived in Fordingbridge from 1927 to 1961. The talk, entitled "Brilliant Destiny", looks at John's early life up until 1914.

Fordingbridge Museum Manager Jane Ireland said, "We are fortunate to have been successful in getting Dr David Boyd Haycock to deliver this talk. He is a freelance art historian and curator and writer who is a Visiting Research Fellow at Oxford Brookes University. He has just published a book on the early life of Augustus John which will be available at the talk."

The talk will cover the life of John up until the start of the Great War when he was one of the most important British artists of the time. The novelist Virginia Woolf called the period, "the age of Augustus John", whilst the author and painter Wyndham Lewis called the ten years up to 1914, "the Augustan Decade".

The lecture will cover John's rapid rise to fame from his birth in South Wales in 1878 to becoming the man almost every young British art student wished to emulate. It will also examine the personalities who influenced him and his relationship with his sister, the artist Gwen John, who also has Fordingbridge connections.

The talk is at Avonway Community Centre in Fordingbridge. It starts at 7.30 and tickets are £10 to include light refreshments. They are available from Fordingbridge Bookshop, Fordingbridge Museum or www.ticketsource.co.uk

Funding available to improve the energy efficiency of New Forest homes

New Forest residents can apply for funding to improve the energy efficiency of their homes.

Residents who live in homes with a mains gas supply could be eligible for funding up to £10,000, and those without a mains gas supply could receive up to £25,000.

People who live in the district qualify for funding if their homes have an energy performance certificate (EPC) rating of E, F, or G, and they have a total household income of £36,000 or less or they receive a means-tested benefit.

Residents can find out the EPC rating of their home by visiting https://www.gov.uk/find-energy-certificate.

The funding is available through the Warmer Homes programme, which can be used to install energy efficient measures such as insulation, solar PV panels, and air source heat pumps. This is as well as high heat retention storage heaters in properties that do not have a mains gas supply.

Cllr Steve Davies, Portfolio Holder for Housing and Homelessness, said: "The Warmer Homes funding programme is a great opportunity



for eligible residents to improve the energy efficiency of their homes. The installation of these measures, which includes solar panels, insulation, air source heat pumps, and more, will help to reduce the cost of our residents' energy bills, and ensures that we are working towards achieving both our and the government's climate aim of becoming net zero carbon by 2050."

Funding is available first come first serve until March 2025 and is subject to eligibility and the EPC rating of each home.

Funding from the Warmer Homes programme is available to owner-occupiers and private rental tenants. Landlords of private rental tenants can apply but will be required to make a financial contribution.

The Royal Maundy

In a tradition which goes back to the 13th Century, Queen Camilla presented Royal Maundy Money to 75 women and 75 men in Worcester Cathedral on Maundy Thursday (28th March 2024).



The service takes its name from the Latin word meaning commandment and its opening words are 'Jesus said, I give you a new commandment'

The number of recipients is related to the years of the Sovereigns life, King Charles being 75 there were 75 men and 75 women honoured. They are chosen from the Diocese of England, Scotland, Ireland and Wales drawing together members of Christian congregations

from every part of the United Kingdom.
