Ringwood residents to vote on neighbourhood plan

A referendum relating to the adoption of the Ringwood Neighbourhood Development Plan will be held on Thursday 4 July 2024.

A Neighbourhood Development Plan contains policies for the use of land in a designated neighbourhood area. The designated Neighbourhood Plan Area is the whole of Ringwood Parish.

The question which will be asked in the Referendum is: 'Do you want New Forest District Council and New Forest National Park Authority to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Ringwood to help it decide planning applications in the Neighbourhood Area?"

Residents will be asked to vote either 'yes' or 'no' to this question. In 2018, Ringwood Town Council decided to produce a Neighbourhood Plan and a number of public consultations were undertaken from 2021 to 2023 on the draft Neighbourhood Plan.

Work on the Ringwood Neighbourhood Development Plan has been overseen locally by a steering group of town councillors and community representatives. The initial Pre-Submission Neighbourhood Plan was published in February 2023 for public consultation.



Understanding Investments - Pension Changes linked to the Lifetime Allowance (LTA)

It's over a year ago since the government announced the abolition of the pension Lifetime Allowance. This significant change has now received Royal Assent under the Finance Bill 23/24 and the changes are finally clear.

For the sake of brevity, this article will highlight some of the key points and considerations we have identified which relate to our clients. However this is a highly complex area so the information is not exhaustive and you should speak to a financial adviser about your own personal situation.

Lump Sum Allowance (LSA) and Lump Sum Death Benefit Allowance (LSDBA):

The LTA has been replaced by the LSA and LSDBA. The levels of these are the same as the previous LTA so £1,073,100 for the LSD-BA and £268,275 for the LSA (tax-free cash).

In effect, the total tax-free cash available to draw from all pensions is £268,275 from now on (still limited to 25% of your pension fund value). This means if you receive a Defined Benefit (DB) pension after April 6th 2024 with no tax-free cash, you can still draw up to £268,275 of tax-free cash from your other pensions (assuming the TFC doesn't exceed 25% of your pension value). That is a very positive change from the old rules.

What if you started to take a DB pension before April 6th 2024? In that instance it is assumed that you used up a % of your LSA which was linked to the old % used of your LTA (for example if you used up 50% of the LTA that would be £536,550 so it's assumed that 25% of that would have been tax-free cash so £134,137.50 even if you didn't actually receive that in tax-free cash).

You are now able to apply for a Transitional Tax-Free Amount certificate (TTFAC) if the tax-free cash you took was less than 25%. However you can only do this before the first benefit crystalisation

event post April 6th 2024 so it's important you seek advice if you have significant pension savings remaining and have previously taken benefits from a DB pension.

The LSDBA is the amount that may be paid as a tax free lump sum with any amount in excess of available LSDBA subject to income tax at marginal rates. Therefore this can be avoided if your pension allows for Beneficiary Drawdown and you have the correct nominations in place. Again if you aren't sure then either check with your pension provider or seek advice.

The limits noted above may be higher if you have previously applied for Pension Protection. In addition you are now able to contribute to your pension without breaking your protection.

There are many more rules and caveats, so if you think that you could be affected by these changes because you have significant pension savings/benefits, then I would urge you to seek advice from a financial professional. Any article can only cover off limited information and only by relating your specific situation to the new rules can opportunities or threats be identified.

Skin Cancer - Latest protection advice

Opt for broad-spectrum SPF50 with at least four-star UVA protection. Studies suggest we generally only apply a third of the sunscreen we need to reach the SPF advertised on the bottle, so the higher the SPF, the better.

- You need to apply the equivalent of six to eight teaspoons for your whole body.
- You may want to reapply sunscreen after an hour to help fill in gaps and offer extra protection.
- Reapply sooner if you've been in the water, even if your sunscreen claims to be waterproof.
- Avoid direct sunlight whenever your shadow is shorter than you -

that's when the sun is strongest. This is roughly 11am to 3pm.

- Wear a hat with a brim of at least 7cm and clothes with a tight weave to block UV rays. If you can see through the garment, it won't offer much protection.
- Remember often-missed areas, such as the backs of legs, ears and the tops of feet. Women are most likely to develop melanoma on their legs and men on their backs.
- Don't be complacent because it's not hot or sunny. Harmful UV rays can be present even on cloudy and cool days between mid-March and mid-October.

Fordingbridge Mini Rugby Celebrate at their Awards

April's Fordingbridge Mini Rugby Awards saw 177 mini rugby players celebrate a tremendous season of rugby. Each player received a trophy to mark their success for the year and a special mention from their coaches. Family and friends gathering to congratulate and cheer on their recognition.

The Under 4s to Under 12s category provides a positive, friendly and fun community environment in which the children can develop from tag rugby through to full contact.

Fordingbridge Mini Rugby continues to go from strength to strength, with 40 amazing and dedicated volunteers in the section making sure that England RFUs TREDS are at the heart of the values of the club - thank you! Ed Murphy, Fordingbridge Mini Rugby Chair said: "We pride ourselves on positive coaching, encouraging kids to gain confidence and believe in themselves. Sport can be such a force for good in young people's lives and an important part of the local community."

This year saw tremendous success for Fordingbridge across the age groups at all of the rugby festivals they entered, with the Under 12s coming runners up in the Hampshire tournament against some massive clubs.

Chess Adventures from Ringwood to Canada

Its late when I eventually make it to Downtown Toronto. I've travelled 3500 miles to see the final rounds of The Candidates chess tournament but thanks to a delayed flight and missed connection I've had an unplanned 24 hours in Amsterdam! The Candidates is held every two years with eight of the top men and women battling it out in two separate tournaments. The winners of each section get the chance to become World Champion as they get to play head-to-head matches against the current champions.

A combination of factors including lots of enforced time inside during the pandemic and the popular Netflix series 'The Queen's Gambit' have led to a big increase in the popularity of chess over the last few years. Keen to make a positive contribution during the pandemic, the Ringwood Chess Club did some innovative work organising online tournaments, so people still had a chance to play competitively even when it wasn't possible to meet in person for over the board matches. This work combined with offering an environment that welcomes players of all standards and offers opportunity to play across a range of levels led to the club winning the English Chess Federations "Small Club of the Year" award which was a great achievement.

Back at the Candidates in Toronto, my interlude in Holland means I've only made it in time for the 14th and final round. It turned out to be a dramatic day. Out of the 16 players that qualified for the tournament five were 22 or under which included two Indian teenagers in the Open section – Pragg (18) and Gukesh (17). The women's tournament has had some exciting games but overall hasn't been too surprising with former world champion Tan Zhongyi from China winning.

However, the Open section hasn't followed the script with teenager Gukesh heading into the final round in the lead just ahead of three pre-tournament favourites – two Americans and one Russian. All four still had a chance to win the tournament with one game to go. After Gukesh drew his last round the outcome of the tournament

depended on the final topsy-turvey game that improbably ended in a draw. That meant that Gukesh held on to his half point lead and became the youngest player to win the Open section of tournament. He will go on to challenge current World Champion Ding Liren from China in November.

There is a big increase in young players breaking through at the top level of the game as evidenced at The Candidates. However, beyond the elite level and all the way to the grass roots it seems chess has captured the imagination of young players across the globe in a new way. At Ringwood we're seeing the numbers of juniors at the club quickly rising and the club actually outgrew official "small club" status between the time the nomination was submitted, and the awards being given - mostly through new juniors joining. Fortunately, the awards committee were so impressed with what the club had done they decided the award was still merited.

Looking ahead, at Ringwood we are keen to continue with a growing emphasis on offering development opportunities to players of all standards from beginners playing friendly games to high level competitive team matches in the Southampton and Dorset leagues. Following the success of the inaugural Ringwood Rapid Play tournament last year (which sold out with 60 entrants) we are hosting the second edition of the tournament at Greyfriars on June 23rd. The club meets at Greyfriars on Mondays from 7pm. Membership fees have been waived for June and July so anyone wanting to come along and play is welcome. 



Community Group Successfully gets the River Avon at Fordingbridge Designated as an Official Bathing Water.

Fordingbridge Avon Bathers (FAB) has been campaigning for the last 14 months to get bathing water designation for the Hampshire Avon at Fordingbridge Recreation Ground to highlight local water quality issues and ensure regulators can hold polluters to account. We are delighted to say we have been successful, and our site was one of 27 new sites announced by DEFRA today.

Now that the site is officially designated, the Environment Agency is responsible for testing the water quality during the bathing season (May to Sept). The site will then receive a classification of Excellent, Good, Sufficient or Poor at the end of the bathing season as an outcome of the water quality testing. The regulator has a responsibility at Poor classified sites to prevent, reduce or eliminate the causes of pollution and identify the reasons it didn't receive a higher classification.

Our own testing of E.Coli throughout 2023 bathing water season has shown that the river Avon would fail to meet minimum standards for bathing water, with Fordingbridge, Downton and Salisbury receiving an equivalent of Poor status. The annual classification is based on a statistical analysis of all samples, and generally, during dry summer conditions, levels of E.Coli were low. However, after rainfall or during the winter when combined sewer overflows (CSO) are operating, levels of E.Coli are significantly higher. The river Avon has the highest levels of protection afforded to any river in the country, being both a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) and a Special Area of Conservation (SAC). Unfortunately, despite significant efforts from multiple organisations, the river fails to meet both standards.

Bathing water status isn't just about swimmers; it will help ensure our special river is protected for all who enjoy it, from anglers to children paddling. Rivers are vital ecosystems that people rely on for mental and physical health benefits. A healthy river leads to a healthy community. However, at present, only 14% of the UK's inland waterways are in a good ecological status, partly due to pollution from untreated sewage and agricultural waste.

Supported by Surfers Against Sewage, an environmental charity that has been campaigning to end sewage pollution for over 30 years, FAB is part of a movement of communities UK-wide who are using bathing water designation as a mechanism to drive up water quality standards. Who are FAB? - FAB is made up of individuals from Fordingbridge Greener Living (Alison Ayling & Louise Tonkin) and For the Love of Water (FLOW) CIC (Adam Ellis). It has also received significant support from Fordingbridge Town Council, Sir Desmond Swayne MP, the local wild swimmers, and Surfers Against Sewage.

Kirsty Davies, Community Water Quality Officer from Surfers Against Sewage says: "Passionate communities like FAB are leading the way in applying for bathing water status to protect the health of their local waterways, and people's health. We know that inland waterways achieving bathing water designation isn't a silver bullet to improve water quality but it is a vital next step in our plans to lift the lid on polluters, force regulators to act and end sewage pollution for good."

Adam Ellis, Director at For the Love of Water (FLOW) CIC, says, "A healthy river needs lots of clean water and good habitat to thrive, and we are seeing significant pressures with population growth and climate change. Getting a site on the lower Hampshire Avon designated means the Environment Agency can increase their current water quality monitoring in the area. As well as being an important recreational resource, the river Avon is home to threatened species such as the Atlantic Salmon, and I hope that this extra scrutiny will help this struggling population. This is only the first step. We are working with farmers who are testing water on their land and looking at ways we can enhance river habitat. I am grateful for all the support from the community in getting our site designated"

Response from Fordingbridge Town Council

In October 2023 Fordingbridge Town
Council formally supported the application
for bathing water status on the River Avon
at Fordingbridge Recreation Ground.
A clear majority agreed that statutory
water testing and the management plan required for designation would deliver clear
benefits for residents and visitors alike and
be a valuable step towards cleaning up our
river for its many existing users.
It is hoped that the designation will increase pressure to improve bathing water

from sewage works, and reducing or stopping untreated outflows

- More funding and support for Environment Agency and equivalent agencies
- Water companies prioritising investment in improving infrastructure
- Campaigns in which everyone works together – swimmers and other river users, conservationists, authorities etc which could lead to more people getting involved in valuing and caring for their rivers and environment.
- Bathing Water Quality status would help guide swimmers with good relevant information in the summer months on the cleanliness of water in designated spots.



Local charity launches STARF 20 and STARF Week

STARF (Stronger Together Across Ringwood and Fordingbridge) is a local charity that is focused on supporting families in crisis in Ringwood and Fordingbridge.

Families are identified by the 8 state schools in the area and help is provided through; direct financial support in some cases; a School Citizen's Advice Hardship Worker (who reviews family circumstances and advises on ways to tackle their finances); and a counselling team for children and young people to heal young minds and reverse damaging behaviours. On Wednesday 15th May at the Ringwood & Fordingbridge Business Community meeting hosted at Moyles Court School, STARF announced its two new initiatives to supplement the existing donations, grants and partner support. The first is STARF WEEK which is from 10th to 17th June – our local schools are planning lots of fundraising activities in this week, and the charity is inviting the business community and individuals to join and do something in that week to raise some funds. Empower Energy, the founding sponsor, has raised £100,000 for STARF but the charity needs more to fund its aims, hence the second initiative is STARF 20 which is the charity's plan to find 20 businesses prepared to commit to trying to find at least £3,000 per year for STARF through team activities and donations.

At the Ringwood & Fordingbridge Business Community meeting representatives from the local schools (Juliet Wickstead and Barbara Johnson) talked emotionally about the work that the STARF funded School Hardship Worker is doing and how this is making a real difference in people's lives and the depth of need for counselling for children in local schools. Also, Peter Vandervelde,

newly appointed fund raiser for STARF explained "the work that STARF does is critical and has to be properly delivered by trained professionals. Demand is greater than our capacity at the moment and we want to do more. Recycling Tips

CLEAR RECYCLING SACKS, BLACK RUBBISH SACKS, GLASS & GARDEN COLLECTIONS

There are only six types of material that you can put in your **CLEAR RECYCLING SACK**, which are listed below with examples.

Plastic bottles including milk, drinks, toiletries and cleaning product bottles (including lids when attached to the bottle)

Tins including food, pet food, biscuits, sweets, tea and coffee tins Cans including fizzy drinks, beers and lager cans

Aerosols including deodorants, furniture polish, shaving foam, hairspray and air freshener

Paper including newspapers, magazines, directories, catalogues, junk mail, envelopes and stationery

Cardboard including cereal, tea, egg boxes, toilet rolls and cardboard packaging.

If you have items that are not on the above list, put them in your **BLACK RUBBISH SACK** to be collected as household

rubbish.

Do not use black rubbish sacks to dispose of:

garden waste, electrical items, batteries, hazardous waste (such as asbestos), bulky household items, knives, tins of paint (unless completely empty).

You can recycle garden waste though our or you can take it to the tip. Batteries can be recycled at many retail outlets.

The other items listed above can also be taken to the tip.

You can recycle all of your glass bottles and jars in your

BLACK GLASS COLLECTION BOX, or your communal glass bin if you live in flats or communal buildings. Both of these are emptied every four weeks.

What we collect; all glass bottles and jars of all colours and sizes, coffee jars, jam jars, wine, spirit and beer bottles, sauce jars. What we do not collect; drinking glasses, window pane glass, glass kitchenware, crockery, broken glass, light bulbs.

If the box contains incorrect items it won't be collected. The collection crew will leave a card explaining what needs to be removed.

Any glass that we cannot collect can be taken to the tip.

GARDEN WASTE we collect;

grass cuttings, hedge cuttings, weeds and flowers, small branches up to 75mm diameter, leaves and twigs, prunings, Christmas trees (chopped up).

We cannot collect:

food waste/fruit and vegetable peelings, invasive weeds, such as Japanese Knotweed and Himalayan Balsam, soil/rubble/concrete/stones animal waste and bedding, plastic bags/pots/trays, branches over 75mm diameter. logs or tree stumps.

We take your garden waste to a composting site in Hampshire. The garden waste is composted using a process known as open windrow composting. The composting results in Pro-Grow, a high-quality soil conditioner that is available to buy at every tip, also known as Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRCs).
