

Ringwood Town Council Earns Living Wage Employer Accreditation

Ringwood Town Council is proud to announce that it has officially been accredited as a Living Wage Employer. This significant achievement reflects the Council's commitment to fair pay and ensuring that employees are compensated in a manner that reflects the true cost of living. As part of this accreditation, every worker aged 18 and over will now receive a minimum hourly wage of £12, which is higher than the government's current minimum wage for those over 21,

set at £11.44 per hour.

The Real Living Wage is the only rate calculated on the actual cost of living, offering a voluntary benchmark for employers who aspire to provide their staff with a wage that truly meets everyday needs, rather than just the legal minimum. Since its inception in 2011, the Living Wage movement has successfully delivered a pay rise to over 460,000 workers across the UK and injected £3 billion into the pockets of those earning the least.

Cllr John Haywood, Chair of the Council's Staffing Committee, who championed the initiative, shared his enthusiasm: "Ensuring that our employees are paid a fair wage that reflects the true cost of living is not just the right thing to do—it's essential for fostering a motivated, committed workforce. At Ringwood Town Council, we believe in leading by example. By becoming a Living Wage Employer, we are making a clear statement about our values and our dedication to the wellbeing of our staff. This accreditation is a testament to our commitment to supporting the community we serve."

This move by Ringwood Town Council sets a positive precedent for other local employers, encouraging them to consider the Real Living Wage as a standard for fair and sustainable employment practices.

Have you noticed the Purple Verbena on the Roundabout by Ringwood Car Park?

Over the last 2 years the RACE to Green team has been working hard to introduce more pollinator friendly planting and improved habitats around the town. As part of this they designed the beds on the roundabout to provide all year-round interest and reduce the need for watering over the summer. Funded by Knights Brown what you see now is a vision of purple swaying in the wind. The team has also moved 17 tonnes of compost and 10 tonnes of mulch, planted thousands of bulbs and 100s of plants in the beds in Gateway Square opposite Ringwood Meeting House. It was their passion to rejuvenate this area that started the whole project.


planting near Ringwood Infant School.

Poulner Junior School Polytunnel opens!

Ringwood Mayor Rae Frederick had the pleasure of officially opening Poulner Junior School's Polytunnel. The Polytunnel was funded by Ringwood Town Council two years ago and Headteacher Jo Randall was delighted to welcome the mayor to finally open it and see just what has been achieved.

Jo Randall explained 'to make a project like this work and become embedded takes time, so we wanted to open the facility now, so we can show and thank the town council for the funding and to show them how it has evolved. The school values environmental learning and feels that this should be taught alongside academic. The children gain so much from being out in nature and learning wider skills and supporting their own wellbeing. We are delighted to be able to invite the Mayor back to see the progress and thank the Town Council for supporting us.'

Over the last five years the school have adopted a whole school approach to the outdoors, with all children being involved in monthly outdoor learning sessions, weekly groups such as Forest schools and gardening and over 70 children now completing their John Muir award that recognises their involvement in conservation and the environment. The Mayor was delighted to be shown all of the projects by the children with a guided tour. She was very impressed by the knowledge and enthusiasm of the children and commented 'it is so impressive to see the school develop this approach and to see that they are working with so many members of the local community including Ringwood Greening, RACE and the local parent community who help fund and maintain the space alongside the children. The school leaders are doing a fantastic job in giving these young people such a rich education and I am thrilled to be able to hear and see the work that has been done.





The school's vision is based on three key words of learn, grow, thrive and it certainly seems that this is at the heart of their work. The Mayor and supporting visitors were not only shown the areas that have developed, such as the orchard, the sensory garden, pond and allotment, but were also given a box of fresh produce, harvested by the children, to take home to enjoy!





From Corn to Popcorn



Everybody knows the big messy looking cream building in the Market Place. The life of this building has had many twists and turns, but you might not know how it used to look, or the interesting history of what is potentially the most important unlisted building in the town.


A recent talk by Mary Baldwin for **The Ringwood Society** looked at the life and times of the building in depth, but for those who weren't able to attend, perhaps the above photo, dating back to the 1990s from the Society archives might be of interest.

The building was completed in 1868 as the Town Hall and Corn Exchange and has since been a cinema, shopping centre, squash

club and nightclub. In researching the building for the talk, more stories came to light; it has hosted concerts by Status Quo, was reputed to have hosted a top secret debrief after an exercise preparing for D-Day and even hosted a sponsored attempt on the world non-stop squash record in 1983, with an appearance by Olympian; Geoff Capes, who would only a few months later be crowned the World's Strongest Man. These are only three of the stories people in the town could tell you about this building, and whilst some stories may be more every day, the collective memory of the building shows why everyone in the town cares so much about what happens to it.

The building currently sits awaiting it's next chapter, and the Society has high hopes that the future of the building will be settled once and for all. We hope that any scheme submitted will be of the highest quality, deserving of a building with such a rich history. Chairman Joe Moorhouse commented "there is so much passion for this building within the town and we hope that any scheme which is forthcoming is good enough to satisfy the belief that this could once again be the focal building in the town" he continued, "for the last fifty two years people have put profit over place when it comes to this building, and we hope the current discussions will result in a building that is viable, but worth the wait".

The Ringwood Society always welcomes new members to support their work with projects and by joining the executive committee. The more members the Society has, the more which can be achieved! Congratulations to Ringwood School Class of 2024

Ringwood School students are reaping the rewards of their hard work and commitment to their studies as they receive their A-Level results today. It has been a pleasure to greet students this morning as they came into school to collect their results. All students have been keen to share their successes with their teachers and all echoed thanks to the staff who have guided them through their courses over the last two years.

This is the second year of A-Level grades moving back to pre-pandemic levels and we are delighted that the percentage of top grades this year (grades A*/A/B) is at 58% (3% higher than in 2019) with three quarters of students securing at least one of these high grades. The percentage of A*-C grades at A-Level is 80% (as it was in pre-pandemic years) and the average grade at our centre in 2024 is B- once again, the same as in 2019. We are pleased that our pass rate this year is 99.4%. Early calculations suggest that the school has retained a very strong rating from ALPs (a national progress measure for A-Level), which puts Ringwood School amongst the strongest Post 16 providers nationally.

There has been exceptional success in many subjects this year. It has been a particularly strong year for Languages. Our centre % of A*s is 9%, but in French, students have 33% A* (83% A* & A) and

Spanish is not far behind with an incredible 25% of grades at A* (75% A* & A). 
