



Remembrance commemorations in Ringwood

Over the Remembrance period there are a number of commemorative services taking place for the people of Ringwood to come together to remember and honour the service and sacrifice of all those that defended our freedoms and protected our way of life.

This will begin on Saturday 2nd November with a service at the War Graves in Ringwood Cemetery. Poppy crosses will be laid on the graves of service personnel whose last resting place is Ringwood. This service is open to all; meet in the Cemetery Car

Park at 10.45am and then walk to the Graves.

On Sunday 10th November, Remembrance Sunday, there will be various services around the town after which a parade will gather in the Market Place from 11:30am. Shortly after, those assembled will process to the War Memorial Garden where there will be a short service followed by the formal Act of Remembrance at 12 noon. This will be followed by a formal wreath-laying ceremony and a procession back to Market Place.

Members of the public are warmly invited to attend and to bring their own tributes which may be laid at the appropriate time. A short road closure will be in place to allow the procession to take place safely.

On Armistice Day, Monday 11th November, there will be a service at the War Memorial at 10.45am and at 11am the National 2 Minutes Silence will be observed. In accordance with local tradition, the start and end of the silence will be marked by the firing of a maroon which will generate a loud bang to be heard around the



Understanding Investments: Pension Annuities and Drawdowns

What are pension annuities and pension drawdowns? How do pension annuities and drawdowns work? Are pension annuities and drawdowns right for you?

When it comes to taking your pension at retirement, annuities and drawdowns are both well-liked options. They are in addition to your State Pension, which is based on your National Insurance contribution history and is separate from private pensions. Both pension annuities and pension drawdowns allow you to take 25% tax-free from your pension in one go. However, pension drawdown allows you to do it gradually if you wish.

What is a pension annuity?

A pension annuity converts the pension pot you have gathered throughout your life into an income for the rest of your life. In other words, your income is guaranteed so you know exactly how much you will receive and can budget accordingly.

You use your pension pot to buy an annuity. The annuity amount that you receive is based on numerous factors such as the size of your pension pot, your health, and the age at which you retire. You can decide whether you would like to receive a fixed amount each year, which can be paid either monthly, quarterly, half-yearly, or annually. Alternatively, you may choose to have the annuity increase at a set rate or rise in line with inflation.

The majority of annuities stop when you die. However, some annuities continue to provide an income for chosen beneficiaries until their death or allow you to build in value protection on your annuity. These annuity options, however, would reduce the income level of the annuity.

The different types of pension annuities are as follows:

- Lifetime annuities are a standard annuity that guarantees you income for the rest of your life.
- Enhanced annuities take into account your health and lifestyle and could give you a higher income than a standard annuity. Also known as an impaired life annuity, it provides a higher regular sum because you are expected to have a shorter life expectancy.
- Fixed-term annuities provide you with regular income for a fixed period, generally up to 25 years. A guaranteed maturity value may be available at the end of the term, which you can use to select another pension option.

The benefits of pension annuities include peace of mind, and the option to have an agreed guaranteed minimum payment period, useful if you want your annuity to continue to be paid to your

dependents after your death.

There are disadvantages, of course. The lack of flexibility if your circumstances changeyou cannot change your retirement income. Annuities are based on the average age that you might die, so if you die earlier, you receive less. Depending on the annuity rates offered to you, they may not provide the best value for money, and the options of indexing or a fixed sum at maturity can significantly reduce the income you could receive.

Pension Drawdown

Pension drawdown allows you to leave your

money invested and take an income from the pension as and when you need it. The

benefit is that your pension pot remains invested and can grow even after money is taken out. Drawdown is also flexible; you can control when and how much you take money out, with either regular income payments or in lump sums.

There are several benefits to pension drawdown. These include potential investment growth even after you start to take your pension, complete flexibility, allowing you to choose exactly what you draw, and increase or decrease at any time, and the ability to pass your pension pot on as inheritance. If you already have another defined benefit pension or a source of income in retirement such as a buy-to-let property, a flexible drawdown may be better suited to you than a fixed income from an annuity.

There are drawbacks too, of course. If your investments perform poorly, you may need to reduce the income you take, and you will need to regularly review your investments to ensure that you are still on track.

Other options

There are other options when retiring. You could opt to buy short-term annuities or a series of fixed-term annuities that last between one year and twenty years. The benefit of these is that they are more flexible than regular annuities but still give you a secure, regular income and remove investment risk.

Recycling Tips

We collect recycling from all households in the New Forest every week. Your recycling is collected in clear plastic sacks, or from your communal recycling bin if you live in flats.

What should be put in your clear plastic bag?

There are only six types of material that you can put in your clear recycling sack, which are listed below with examples.

- * Plastic bottles including milk, drinks, toiletries and cleaning product bottles (including lids when attached to the bottle)
- * Tins including food, pet food, biscuits, sweets, tea and coffee tins
- * Cans including fizzy drinks, beers and lager cans
- * Aerosols including deodorants, furniture polish, shaving foam, hairspray and air freshener





- * Paper including newspapers, magazines, directories, catalogues, junk mail, envelopes and stationery
- * Cardboard including cereal, tea, egg boxes, toilet rolls and cardboard packaging.

If you have items that are not on the above list, put them in your black rubbish sack to be collected as household rubbish.

You can recycle glass bottles and jars through your black box or communal bin or take it to a community recycling bank.

At some community recycling bank locations, there are charity-run recycling banks for clothing/textiles, shoes, books and CDs.

Residents who are unable to put their sacks out at the edge of their property due to a disability, illness or injury can contact NFDC to request an assisted collection.



A Place on the Rim of a Wood



What's in a name? We take names granted on a daily basis; "Hello my name is Bob, this is my wife Jenny", "my car is an Austin", "I'm going to play game "that badminton", race horse is called Shergar", but who ever has time to stop, take a minute and about where names actually come from and the fact they

might actually have a deeper meaning? Where does the name of the town of Ringwood come from, for example?

There has been some discussion over the years as to how Ringwood actually became the name of the town. Everyone agrees it is an evolution of an older name, but what the older name was depended on who you asked.

The Reverend Peter Hall in his A Few Topographical Remarks Relative to the Parishes of Ringwood, Ellingham, Harbridge and Fordingbridge puts forward Regni Sylva meaning a town among the woods of the ancient Hampshire Regni maritime people. The Doomsday Book of 1086 calls it Rincvede which would derive from a ford (vede) over a watercourse (rinc), both plausible. However, a document from 955 naming the place as Rimucwude suggests an error in transcription of the later document, for rimuc means rim

and wude translates today as wood, much closer to today's name. *Rimucwude* would therefore be describing a settlement on the edge of a forest.

What a lot of people don't realise is that a significant part of the parish of Ringwood is actually in the New Forest National Park. When redesigning The Ringwood Society logo, the designer, John Saunders of Work of Importance, chose to represent this part of the parish and the nature and wildlife of Ringwood town through an illustration of a native *pinus sylvestris* (Scots Pine) tree, the type found throughout the New Forest.

The Ringwood Society promotes the town through their Town Trail, which leads visitors through the town, illuminating the history and character to those who may not be aware. Copies of this can be picked up throughout the town centre.

The Society always welcomes new members to support their work, with projects and by joining the executive committee. The more members the Society has, the more which can be achieved! Membership of the Society is only £10 a year for a single membership, only £18 per year for a couple, with students receiving free membership. 


