





Emperor Quianlong 1735-1796

Members of the Ringwood Antiques Club had little knowledge of the Qing Dynasty in China, which lasted from 1644 to 1911. Our speaker David Rosier lived in Asia for over 25 years and collected more than 700 Imperial Textiles and Costume Accessaries from the Qing period, these are now on display in the Shanghai Museum



Emperor Quianlong was the 4th Quing Emperor to

rule over China and the most influential. An ambitious military leader, he increased the size of China and was also a writer, poet and patron of the arts. He ruled over the largest population and economy in the world. His personal collectons, including thousands of paintings and ceramics are preserved in the Palace Museum in China.

Household Waste and Recycling Centres in the New Forest will not close

We are delighted to hear that tier 3 and tier 4 Household Waste and Recycling Centres (HWRCs) in Hampshire, including two in the New Forest district area at Marchwood and Somerley, will not be closed.

This decision was made by the Hampshire County Council (HCC) Cabinet today (Monday 14 October 2024). It followed written representation by Cllr Geoffrey Blunden, Portfolio Holder for Environment and Sustainability, and direct discussion between the Leader of Hampshire County Council, Cllr Nick Adam-King and Cllr Jill Cleary, Leader of New Forest District Council, to ensure that New Forest resident concerns were clearly articulated and understood.

Cllr Geoffrey Blunden, Portfolio Holder for Environment and Sustainability, stated,

"I am pleased to hear the county has listened to its district colleagues, and will be keeping Marchwood and Somerley recycling centres open for our local community.

"The centres provide a fantastic resource supporting residents to recycle and reuse, and align with our goals to improve recycling, reduce waste, and meet binding Net Zero 2050 targets.

"As we work on plans to rollout a new and improved waste collection service from 2025 to 2026, we look forward to continuing work with Hampshire County Council and other local authorities, to boost recycling rates and reduce our impact on the environment." Funding success at Forest Forge

Forest Forge, the New Forest's leading theatre company, is celebrating after securing $\pm 52,000$ of funding from Arts Council England, alongside a new commission from New Forest District Council.

The professional theatre company, which has been creating and touring theatre for over 40 years, has been granted the funding to support several projects it will be delivering from November to July 2025.

The company has recently restructured its activity to place equal weight on three strands of work: professional touring,



participatory activity and support of local artists. The funding supports new activity in all three areas and is designed to support Forest Forge engage and bring together audiences and participants from across the generations.

One of the projects supported by the grant is Forest Forge's annual Christmas production, created in partnership with New Forest based Bumblefly Theare and with Mischievous Theatre. This year the three

theatre companies are working together to create a family friendly version of A Christmas Carol, which will tour across the region from December. The funding will support additional performances including relaxed and sign language interpreted events. Full details of the tour will be available soon.

Forest Forge are also in the process of developing two new

'Suitcase Story' productions. These smaller touring performances will be designed for libraries, schools, care homes and fetes will be available to tour in 2025. One of the new productions has been supported by the Arts Council funding, whilst the other is a new commission from New Forest District Council's allocation of the Shared Prosperity Fund (UKSPF), from central government, with designated funds for improving the local cultural offer.

Kealy Whenray, Creative and Cultural Development Manager at New Forest District Council says: "NFDC are excited to help facilitate the growth of Forest Forge's presence in the New Forest through our shared strategic objectives, not least our shared vision to develop a vibrant creative and cultural sector within the district. Through our allocation of the Shared Prosperity Fund (UKSPF), from central government, with designated funds for improving the local cultural offer, we have been able to commission work that is energising for our communities, relevant to place and artistically ambitious. This project, excitingly, increases funding for rural theatre production, provides free community performance opportunities and improves access to creative learning for children and young people in the New Forest District."

The Arts Council England investment will also support some research into another of the company's ideas called Unexpected Places which it hopes to launch next year.

The Arts Council grant will also help support new drama workshops across the New Forest, including a new Act Your Age drama group for those over the age of 55 and a new active session for older people and pre-school children. These have also kindly be supported by Culture in Common and will extend Forest Forge's already extensive participation programme.

Supporting artists and regional theatre makers is an important part of Forest Forge's work and so the project includes funding for five developing artists to join the company to gain experience across the work. The company will be advertising these opportunities in the coming weeks and advise anyone interested to keep an eye on social media and the website.

Lucy Phillips and Jo Billingham, Co-Artistic Directors of Forest Forge say:

"We are extremely grateful to receive this funding from Arts Council England and New Forest District Council, alongside support from Culture in Common. We are excited for what is now possible and the difference we can make in the New Forest with this investment. Forest Forge has been through some significant changes in the last year and this funding provides an important opportunity for us to look to the future and to do what we do best - providing theatre and theatre making experiences for and with people in our community."

Make the most of your Pumpkin - Spicy pumpkin soup

It's spooky season and we are stocking up on pumpkins, apples, tasty treats and other hearty and seasonal foods. Unfortunately, 4.5 million tonnes of good food is wasted every year from UK households, that's enough to fill 38 million wheelie bins!

Pumpkins are more than just a pretty jack-o-lantern, they are rich in vitamins and minerals and can be used in both sweet and savoury dishes. You can use all of your pumpkin, even the pumpkin leftovers from your jack-o-lantern and make the most of it. It's sweet and spicy, this pumpkin soup is an autumn favourite and perfect if you're making soup for the first time, as well as for seasoned cooks. It works really well if you roast the pumpkin and sweet potato first. Delicious!

Ingredients

¹/₂ medium pumpkin or ¹/₂ butternut squash
¹Can be made with other roast veg e.g. parsnips, carrots
1 sweet potato
¹/₂ red pepper
¹/₂ cups (375 ml) of water
1 cup (250 ml) full fat milk or alternative milk e.g. soya, almond
1 red chilli (optional)
Pinches of salt and pepper for seasoning **Recipe - serves 1 1**. Preheat the oven to 190°C. **2**. Remove the pumpkin flesh with a spoon, and peel the sweet

potato. Chop the pumpkin and sweet potato into 1 inch cubes. 3. Slice the red peppers and put all vegetables on a roasting tray, with a drizzle of oil. Place in the oven to roast for 30-40 minutes, until soft. **4**. Allow all the vegetables to cool a little. Once cool enough to handle, add the pumpkin,

sweet potato and peppers to a blender with the water, milk and diced chilli, and blend until smooth.

5. Pour into a saucepan and heat until piping hot, adding more water if you like a slightly thinner soup.



6. Season to taste with salt and pepper

7. Chef's tip: To give the soup a sweeter flavour, roast the pumpkin and sweet potato until they are dark and caramelised. It is important to allow the veg to cool before putting in the blender as the pressure of the steam could create a mess in the kitchen!

Variations: To make this a more balanced dish, you can serve with garlic croutons or a few slices of bread and butter. You can also vary the ingredients buy using butternut squash instead of, or as an addition to, the pumpkin!

Extra flavour: Adding your own mix of herbs and spices can really enhance this dish, such as coriander, cumin, oregano or fennel seeds.

Vegan options: To adapt this dish for vegans, replace the milk with vegetable stock, alternative milk or coconut milk, all of which will create different flavours.

Allergy advice: This versatile dish is easily adapted to avoid allergens and be suitable for most diets.

Cousin of Tragic Lymington Stabbing Victim to box at U.W.B.C Event at Bournemouth BIC 16th November to raise money for Lives Not Knives.

Harry Edwards, 22 years from Ringwood, is stepping into the boxing ring for the first time, boxing to raise money and awareness for the Lives Not Knives charity following the death of his beloved cousin and friend, Luke Gray in July this year. Luke died as a 'direct result' of injuries sustained from an attack in October 2021.

Luke, 26 and his best friend Max Maguire, were brutally attacked in Lymington in October 2021. Catastrophically, Max lost his life that night. Luke was stabbed twice in the back, fighting for his own life, he witnessed the murder of his best friend and the serious wounding of another friend with them that night. His heart stopped three times that night. His mum, Sarah Roberts, was told to 'say her goodbyes' and as Covid restrictions were in place was told she could only spend an



hour with him! For two years Luke underwent repeated operations, multiple infections, and treatments, ultimately, Luke had his kidney

removed. Tragically, Luke died in his sleep in July despite the tireless efforts of his devastated mother to revive him, a full two and a half years after that fatal night. Sarah has given us permission to share the coroner's verdict but is in no doubt that 'Luke is dead as a direct result of the attack."

Coroner's Verdict (paraphrased).

"Although the coroner has confirmed Luke's cause of death was ischaemic heart disease, he would have lived into his 60's or longer. This undetected, un-



derlying condition ended his life at just 26 years, due in part to the chronic psychological and physical stress of the attack with a knife in 2021'. As Luke's mum says, "This cannot be proven in a court of law, so Luke will never get the justice he deserves."

Harry, a pall bearer at his cousin's funeral in August, says "Luke was a complete fighter, he fought for two and half years to get over this hideous, unprovoked attack. I have seen the horrendous impact on his mum and her twin sister, my mum – it has affected us all terribly. I am fighting to raise awareness of Lives Not Knives, in the hope that we can do one small thing to help stop the national epidemic of knife crime."

Luke's mum Sarah says "I am tremendously proud of what Harry is doing not only for his cousin my son, but for all the sons and daughters out there that will be lost due to people carrying knives. It must stop. Harry has been training every day and is a real man – I wish everyone that thinks about carrying a knife would think twice, be like Harry and save a life – leave it home or better still hand it in." 

Roland 'Roly' Errington

18 May 1953 - 15 October 2024



Chairman of Ellingham, Harbridge & Ibsley Parish Council and the RAF Ibsley Airfield Heritage Trust,

Roly Errington, who has died at the age of 71, was consulted on matters of conservation, planning, and ecology by organisations ranging from the Friends of the New Forest (New Forest Association), The National Park Authority, The National Trust, and a host of archaeological, aviation and WW2 historical research groups throughout Hampshire. His famously vast knowledge on a wide-range of topics was such that people both locally and in the film industry in which he had worked as a lighting cameraman for decades, knew he could provide the answer to any question they might care to ask - and if he didn't, he would find it for them.

Roly was the second son of the late George Errington (OBE), who test-flew Spitfires, Hurricanes, Mosquitoes, and Horsa Gliders for the war effort, while his late mother, the redoubtable Lesley Errington was a well-known local figure herself, serving as a respected town and Parish councillor for 33 years, and also as Chairman of the New Forest District Council from 1976 - 1978.

Educated at Radley College and Manchester University where he read Mechanical Engineering, Roly ultimately plumped for a career in film. Whilst still at school, he'd spent time shadowing Sir David Lean on the set of 'Ryan's Daughter', and had been given the unenviable task of wrangling Robert Mitchum and Trevor Howard out of their beds and onto the set. Although still only in his late teens, with his wittily disarming personality and extraordinary ability to persuade, he apparently managed this with relative ease.

His later CV included 'Mission Impossible', and 'Shakespeare in Love', but his skill with and knowledge of CGI and enhanced effects saw him in demand for the growingly popular fantasy film genre, working on such films as 'Snow White and The Huntsman' and 'Willow'. Intensely private, he would work under various professional names to keep his film career and his voluntary work as a New Forest parish councillor separate.

The New Forest remained his first love, and his passion for its survival and conservation unparalleled. For those who were aware of it, his extraordinary ability to communicate intuitively with animals offered comfort and answers to friends wishing to understand their pets and their local wildlife. Visitors to his home near Ringwood would find a haven for foxes, badgers, birds, and the occasional duck, up from the lake, and taking an afternoon nap on the top of the bookshelves in his study.

During the early summer of 2024, Roly had been feeling increasingly unwell. When he finally secured an appointment to see a doctor for tests to be performed, it was discovered he had a type of cancer that often only makes its presence known when it is already too late.

Following a collapse at home on 6 October 2024, he was rushed to Bournemouth Hospital, where he died 7 days later.

He is survived by his long-term companion and wife, Emma.

Recently John and his beloved wife Sylvia celebrated their 64th Wedding Anniversary!

John reflects that volunteering as an archivist gives him worthwhile occupation during his retirement years - "This has been something that has kept me mentally active and serving the community". Bravo John!
