Changes at Ringwood Foodbank

In 2023/24 our distribution centres in Ringwood, Fordingbridge and Verwood provided a total of 42,000 meals to those in need in our communities demonstrating the continuing need for our services. We wanted to let our communities know about some changes in the way we operate.

Our Ringwood distribution centre has now moved to the Greyfriars activity centre where, as well as our food distribution area, we have a comfortable area for clients to enjoy a hot drink and a chat. Citizens Advice Financial Inclusion workers are now present at each session to help our clients and from November Hammersley Homes, a local mental health charity, will be operating a drop in session each Wednesday. We are also offering space for drop in facilities to other charities and organisations who share our objective of alleviating poverty. Unfortunately our Fordingbridge distribution centre is having to leave the United Reform Church hall, where we currently operate from, by 31st December as the Church is closing. We are urgently looking for new premises to run the Fordingbridge distribution centre from, ideally close to the centre of the town. Please let us know if you can help.

Ringwood Foodbank has now changed its charitable status to that of a Charitable Incorporated Organisation. We are still registered with the Charity Commission and there will be little or no impact on our day to day operation. However one consequence of this move is that we have had to change our bank accounts. We have tried to contact all our regular financial donors to advise them of the change but have been unable to contact all. 

Understanding Investments: Key Areas of Change post Budget 2024

There was an unusually long gap between election day and budget day with many rumours and much speculation bordering on hysteria. Now we can move onto facts (or facts as we know them, since measures may well change before they become effective). For the sake of brevity, I won't cover changes which only affect a small number of people, nor things that weren't changed. Instead I will focus on three changes which may affect a large number of people in regard to their personal financial planning.

1: Pensions and Inheritance Tax (IHT)

There were strong rumours that we could see a change to the tax treatment of pension death benefits and this has materialized. From April 2027, most pension death benefits will be included in the estate for IHT purposes.

This will require careful financial planning to work out the most tax-efficient way to release income in retirement, considering all tax wrappers available. However there is now a consultation period during which the practicalities and processes of how to implement this change will be considered. It is important to wait for the outcome of the consultation so that all the details are clear before making significant changes to existing plans. This will include clarity on the tax treatment for beneficiaries and whether the current change to their treatment on death post age 75 will continue (income drawn from the pension as beneficiary drawdown is currently tax-free if the pension holder dies pre age 75 or is taxed as income at the beneficiaries tax rate if the pension holder dies post age 75). If death benefits are subject to IHT at any age, there is the risk of double-taxation post age 75.

2: Capital Gains Tax (CGT)

Capital gains tax rates increased on 31st October 2024 to 18% for basic rate taxpayers and 24% for higher rate and additional rate taxpayers, up from 10% and 20% respectively. There is no change to CGT rates on residential property, which continue to be taxed at 18% and 24%. There is no change to the CGT annual exemption of £3,000 for individuals and £1,500 for trusts.

For many years CGT rates have been attractive compared to income tax rates. In addition there were generous annual exemptions which have been reduced during the past 2 years from £12,000 for individuals and £6,000 for trusts to the current levels notes above. This resulted in clients often investing in General Investment Accounts (GIAs) once they had fully utilized their tax-efficient wrappers such as ISAs and pensions. Due to the now increased CGT rates and reduced annual exemptions, it will be important that clients review the different tax wrappers available for their investments that sit outside of their ISAs and pensions. This may include consideration of onshore and offshore bond wrappers.

3: ISAs and the proposed "British ISA"

There are no changes to the current ISA subscription limits and no cap on accumulated ISA savings. The "British ISA" proposed at the last budget will not go ahead.



It was a day for celebration last Friday (1st Nov) with the formal launch of the "Ringwood Community Hub" at Long Lane, Ringwood.

Young players from Ringwood Town FC and enthusiastic "walking footballers" from the Club's site partners AFCB CST showed their enjoyment of playing football on the 3G Artificial Turf Pitch before joining guests in the new pavilion for the formal opening ceremony.

Past and present members from the Club mingled with town councillors and NFDC councillors and representatives from local

company Knights Brown, the main contractor for the project. Rae Frederick, Town Mayor and Chair of the Council, and Jill Cleary, Leader of NFDC, both spoke highly of the "amazing facilities" available for the community.

In his speech Phil King, Chair RTFC, said "Throughout its long history the club has always been dedicated to providing organised football for the youth of the town and engaging with the wider community ... we can now offer a fantastic environment for everyone to enjoy their football and for that amazing community spirit to continue."

Steve Cuss, Head of AFCB Community Sports Trust, was joined by Jeff Mostyn Community Sports Trust Ambassador, said "We now look forward to maximising the investment and usage of the site by the local Ringwood population through community engagement projects."

The Story of 50 Years of the Ringwood Judo Club in Greyfriars

In the summer of 1974 Gillian Habbin, the then Warden of Greyfriars, approached Keith Adams asking if he was prepared to start a Judo Class for children.

There had been a Junior Judo Class in Greyfriars in the early 1960's but this had long since folded so that in 1974 the only Judo in Ringwood was in a further education evening class in the Ringwood Secondary School. Keith agreed. The mats (tatami) from the 1960's had been stored and were now utilised to make a tatami in the Small Hall. The class was a success even though many of the children were the sons/daughters/acquaintances etc. of the adult players in the further education class. Very soon after, probably in the summer of 1975, the further education class closed, and most of the players, who were known as The Ringwood Judo Club moved to Greyfriars, and so Greyfriars became the home of the Ringwood Judo Club.

In January 1977 the Greyfriars Hall (which incorporated The Small Hall) was opened. Additional mats, canvas, and frame were purchased to make a County competition sized mat area. The Club membership expanded and its players became a force to be reckoned with in County and Area competitions with some members both junior and senior becoming members of County and Southern Area Judo Squads and winning medals at all levels of competitions including National Championships.

It was during this time that the Hampshire Judo League was formed and the clubs Ladies and Girls Teams were undefeated during the whole of the league's existence. The Men and Boys could however only manage runners-up in their respective leagues.



In 1978 the club joined with the Matsumachi Judo Club of Christchurch in a twinning arrangement with the Honfleur and Deauville Judo Clubs of France. Several exchanges were made over the next few years and many friendships were made, some of which exist today.



It was in the 1970's and 1980's that the club entered floats in the Ringwood Carnival as a way of advertising its activities. Groundwork predominated but some throws were carried out when the procession was at times stationary.

In October 1992 the Club moved into the new Activities Centre. Ray Stephans Olympic Judo Silver Medalist came to formally welcome the Club into its new home where it still meets every Monday and Wednesday evenings, with Junior being 6.30pm till 8pm and the Adult Class 8pm 'till 9.30pm. Additional modern tatami and crash mats have been purchased giving the Club a very large mat area. The Club is now able to host the Hampshire Randori (free practice) Sessions when adult players from many clubs come to practice.

Keith retired from Judo in 2020 and several British Judo Association (BJA) coaches have since run the Club but the current team of four is led by Didier Di Mario (Didi for short) The Club has a thriving membership at both Junior and Senior levels with some international players among its membership.

The Autumn Budget **Unveils Significant** Changes to **Inheritance Tax**



The 2024 Autumn Budget introduces key changes to Inheritance Tax (IHT), impacting financial planning for individuals and families. Nil Rate Bands Remain Frozen

The nil rate band will remain frozen at £325,000 until 5 April 2030, marking 21 years since the last increase! The residence nil rate band stays at £175,000, with the taper starting at £2 million. As more estates fall within the IHT net, individuals should consider gifting or transferring assets now, with a particular view to retaining the valuable residence nil rate band.

Unused Pension Funds to be Subject to IHT

Starting 6 April 2027, the government will incorporate unused pension funds into an individual's estate for IHT purposes. This significant change underscores the need for careful estate planning to mitigate the tax implications for beneficiaries.

Changes to IHT Relief for Agricultural and Business Property

In a widely criticised decision within the farming sector, agricultural and business property will retain 100% IHT relief up to a combined limit of £1 million starting 6 April 2026. Any value above this limit will receive 50% relief. These changes may mean that heirs will need to sell or borrow to finance the tax liability, making IHT planning essential.

Business property relief will be reduced from 100% to 50% for guoted shares designated as 'not listed' on recognised stock exchange markets, like AIM.

Agricultural Property Relief Expanded

Beginning 6 April 2025, Agricultural Property Relief will expand to include land managed under environmental agreements with the UK government or other government entities. Individuals should consider assessing their eligibility under these new regulations.



HISTORY & NEWS

Lighting Up the Centre of Town



Perhaps one of the most unique structures in the town, the Jubilee Lamp, is a central feature within the Market Place, but it hasn't always found favour or been kept in the best condition.

In the centre of Ringwood Market Place sits an unusual five lantern street light, which originally incorporated a drinking fountain at its base. The was erected for the Golden Jubilee of Queen Victoria in 1887 and paid for by public subscription. Comments by a local historian in 1894 that "the writer cannot bring himself to speak of it in any terms of praise" was perhaps a sign of things to come.

During the next 80 or so years, the original gas lit lanterns were removed to be replaced by an unfortunate electric lamp, the drinking fountain was concreted in and the central post became a home for a sign directing people to public toilets. Add in front car parking and a long running snack van, and things were looking pretty bleak for this icon of the town.

The Silver Jubilee of Queen Elizabeth II in 1977 brought about an opportunity to return the lamp to its former glory and it was given a complete restoration with five new lanterns being made to

replicate the lost originals and the lamp was once again visible in its original glory. A further scheme of works in 1994 revealed the makers to have been the iron foundry; George Smith & Co of Glasgow.

When redesigning The Ringwood Society logo, the designer, John Saunders of Work of Importance, chose to represent the community of Ringwood by illustrating the Jubilee Lamp, which is both at the physical heart of the town and is the backdrop to so many community events including the Carnival, Pedal Car Grand Prix and of course, Christmas Eve.

The Ringwood Society promotes the town through their Town Trail, which leads visitors through the town, illuminating the history and character to those who may not be aware. Copies of this can be picked up throughout the town centre.

The Society always welcomes new members to support their work, with projects and by joining the executive committee. The more members the Society has, the more which can be achieved! Membership of the Society is only £10 a year for a single membership, only £18 per year for a couple, with students receiving free membership. Her love of her garden, her country pursuits (particularly fishing) and her organisational skills overseeing ploughing matches, the Carvers gates on Carnival day and the RMDS Summer Shows at Greyfriars have all been recalled by her many friends and admirers.

She will be greatly missed by all who knew her and undoubtedly live on in the history of Greyfriars. We are forever thankful to her.

A memorial service for Gillian will be held in Ringwood Parish Church on Tuesday 26th November at 1pm and afterwards at Greyfriars at 2.15pm. A book of condolence has been opened at Greyfriars; any personal letters will be passed on to her family.


