Understanding Investments: Reflections on the investment year

I hope 2024 has been a good year for you. It's certainly been politically eventful (significant changes in Governments both here and in the US) and economically encouraging (inflation levels falling back, albeit still slightly elevated, and interest rates appearing to have peaked), whilst geo-political concerns continue.

From an investment perspective, we had endured 2 challenging investment years and I am pleased to say that 2024 has rewarded patience with balanced portfolio returns in excess of 10%. Whilst most global economies continue to suffer from low growth, the US economy performed well. The trigger for the strong investment returns was interest rates peaking and starting to come down, whilst at the same time an expectation that this would happen without the world (and specifically the US) entering a recession. Of course a recession could still happen but what markets really fear is a deep recession and that appears highly unlikely, barring a "black-swan" event none of us are talking about today. So it's been a good investment year!

Looking ahead, fixed interest investments are yielding between 4% and 7% and equities look reasonable value (other than some tech companies where growth expectations are high and could disappoint). Therefore we are positive looking ahead over the next 5 years. The low risk portion of portfolios (fixed interest) should contribute a strong yield (interest payments) which means there is less demand on equities to do all the "heavy lifting" to achieve a reasonable return. In addition, new governments are focused on supporting growth (whether we agree or not on how they go about it) which should be broadly supportive for equities.

On the flip side, geo-political concerns continue. Sadly, this is forever the case and in our opinion not a primary reason to avoid investing (otherwise you'd never invest and would miss out in the long-term). Equity markets are also likely to see a return to some volatility as they have been comparatively benign in 2024. The political decisions coming out of the US may be more controversial and erratic as the new government leverage and flex their muscle in trade talks and foreign policy. Again market volatility is normal and shouldn't be feared by long-term investors. It's better to tune-

out of short-term commentary and news headlines which aim to be dramatic and instead view declines as opportunities for the long-term.

In the UK the recent budget was big news. We did send an update post-budget so I won't dwell on all the changes and instead will mention one on which further advice will follow during the next 12 months and will require some detailed financial planning. The taxation of pension death benefits is changing from April 2027 and they will become liable to inheritance tax (the spousal exemption still applies so no IHT if left to a spouse). For many clients, pensions have been the last place from which to draw income or tax-free cash whilst the pension values were excluded from IHT.

In fact many clients earmarked their surplus pension savings to pass down to children and grandchildren inheritance tax-free. That is changing and will require careful planning ahead of the rule change in 2 years' time.

Moving on, our Ringwood office continues to thrive. We believe that our offering of local, personal face to face independent advice, delivered by highly qualified advisers, is attractive. Thank you to our clients. We will never take your trust and loyalty for granted.





Top Inheritance Tax Planning Mistakes to Avoid

Overlooking the Seven-Year Rule for Lifetime Gifts

Gifting assets during your lifetime can reduce IHT, but many misunderstand the seven-year rule and taper relief. If you pass away within seven years of gifting, those assets remain part of your estate for tax purposes. Taper relief applies only to the value above the nil rate band, not the entire gift.

Diane's Solution: "Work closely with an adviser to ensure your gifts are structured in the most beneficial manner. We often recommend a strategy of making regular smaller gifts, which can fall within annual exemptions and be exempt from IHT straight away."

Church Stars Light the Road to Christmas

Two illuminated stars have caught the eye of locals and travellers on the A31 at Ringwood. New Vicar, Revd Stephen Miles had placed a star on his previous church at Christmas and suggested placing two on the tower of Ringwood Parish Church. The stars, some 5 metres high, had to be assembled on the roof of the church tower. 'The stars had to be as big as possible, but we had to get all the bits up four stories of spiral staircase and then three long ladders to get to the roof. Then we needed a break in the weather to put it all together. We have had issues with rain getting into the lights – it's very exposed. But the response we have had has been overwhelming. The three of us who put it up have been absolutely amazed,' said Paul Gray, who coordinated the project.


The first star was in place for Ringwood's annual Winter Wanderland on 1st December when the town Christmas lights were switched on in front of 2,000 people. They will stay on the church tower until the end of the Christmas season.

Jacqueline Brown, Churchwarden said, 'We always get lots of messages about the tower and flag; for many people it's a well-loved landmark, visible from many miles away, but the response this time has been really incredible.' Revd Miles, who came to the Parish of Ringwood in September, was enthusiastic: 'When you walk around in a clergy dog-collar, it's not unusual to be stopped and asked why anyone should have hope. I think this is part of the answer: the Christmas message is as relevant as ever and the stars hopefully cause people to think a little more deeply about it. We've had such a wonderfully positive response to the stars, and I'd like to think that the people of Ringwood and surrounding areas can Follow the Star this Christmas and find the joy and hope they are seeking.'


Sarah approached Shelter and proposed she release the story as a way to raise money and awareness for the charity.

After the great success of the 'Memories of Ringwood Railway' exhibition at Grevfriars and The Meeting House over the Summer, The Ringwood Society have since turned their attention to the next phase of their lottery funded project.

A forgotten corner of land on Castleman Way has been transformed into a permanent reminder of the town's railway heritage.

New signage has been erected, four replacement trees planted, remaining railway features restored and an interpretation board added to bring the history of the town's railway to passers by.

The specially produced videos from the exhibition remain available on the revamped Society website, and there will be an official opening of the site in the New Year.




Medieval Women and Where To Find Them



250g unsalted butter 200g dark muscovado sugar 7 tsp golden syrup 600g plain flour 2 tsp bicarbonate of soda 4 tsp ground ginger

Decorations -

2009 flaked almonds

2 egg whites

500g icing sugar

1259 mini chocolate

Generous selection of sweets

Lingerbread House Recipe

- Heat the oven to 200C/18OC fan/gas 6. Melt the butter, sugar and syrup in a pan. Mix the flour, bicarbonate of soda and ground ginger into a large bowl, then stir in the butter mixture to make a stiff dough. If it won't quite come together, add a tiny splash of water.
- Cut out the template (download from the tips below). Put a sheet of baking paper on a work surface and roll about one quarter of the dough to the thickness of two £1 coins. Cut out one of the sections, then slide the gingerbread, still on its baking paper, onto a baking sheet. Repeat with remaining dough, re-rolling the trimmings, until you have two side walls, a front and back wall and two roof panels. Any leftover dough can be cut into Christmas trees, if you like.
- 3. Pick out the most intact flaked almonds and gently poke them into the roof sections, pointy-end first, to look like roof tiles. Bake all the sections for 12 mins or until firm and just a little darker at the edges. Leave to cool for a few minutes to firm up, then trim around the templates again to give clean, sharp edges. Leave to cool completely.
- 4. Put the egg whites in a large bowl, sift in the icing sugar, then stir to make a thick, smooth icing. Spoon into a piping bag with a medium nozzle. Pipe generous snakes of icing along the wall edges, one by one, to join the walls together. Use a small bowl to support the walls from the inside, then allow to dry, ideally for a few hours.
- 5. Once dry, remove the supports and fix the roof panels on. The angle is steep so you may need to hold these on firmly for a few mins until the icing starts to dry. Dry completely, ideally overnight. To decorate, pipe a little icing along the length of 20 mini chocolate fingers and stick these lengthways onto the side walls of the house. Use three, upright, for the door.
- 6. Using the icing, stick sweets around the door and on the front of the house. To make the icicles, start with the nozzle at a 90-degree angle to the roof and squeeze out a pea-sized blob of icing. Keeping the pressure on, pull the nozzle down and then off – the icing will pull away, leaving a pointy trail. Repeat all around the front of the house. Cut the chocolate mini roll or dipped Flake on an angle, then fix with icing to make a chimney. Pipe a little icing around the top. If you've made gingerbread trees, decorate these now, too, topping each with a silver ball, if using. Dust the roof with icing sugar for a snowy effect. Lay a winding path of sweets, and fix gingerbread trees around and about using blobs of icing.
