The Ringwood & Fordingbridge Talking News was established some thirty years ago reading and recording the local news extracted from local newspapers for the benefit of the Blind or Visually Impaired working out of a unit at St Leonards Hospital.

Over the years it moved to the old Council Offices in Christchurch Road then to Ringwood Medical Centre and most recently to the library in St Ives Care Home. Every fortnight a round-up of the local news is distributed on CD, Memory Stick or can be accessed by any one on line at bit.ly/3Tx2dDv.

Although primarily distributing the News to individuals an increasing number are going into Care Homes in the area where they are listened to in groups or by residents in their own rooms. This is a completely free service with the tasks of editor, reader or engineer carried out by volunteers.

# River Avon Bathing Water Status

Fordingbridge Greener Living along with FLOW (For the Love of Water) CIC welcomed over 40 people to Avonway in Fordingbridge to hear an update on the quality of the water in the River Avon in Fordingbridge which is a designated Bathing Area.

Guest speakers Jim Flory, Area Environment Manager from the Environment Agency, and Matt Wheeldon, Director of Infrastructure Development at Wessex Water, presented results of tests by their respective organisations over the last bathing season.

#### **Environment Agency**

Jim Flory began by explaining that statutory testing is for faecal bacteria only, specifically E-Coli and Intestinal E...... Overall, the testing for the season has resulted in a classification of 'Poor' water quality. The next step is for the Environment Agency to investigate the sources of the pollution and then to work on reducing it. They are clear that the pollution is most likely to be human sewage, the main sources of which are likely to be Salisbury and Downton, although there are small amounts from most of the villages. Private septic tanks can be source of pollution. There is a direct correlation between high rainfall and sewage pol-

There is a direct correlation between high rainfall and sewage pollution and the Environment Agency is developing models to help become more predictive of water quality.

#### Wessex Water

Matt Wheeldon explained that Wessex Water deals with a very large Avon catchment area with many rivers feeding into the Avon before it gets to Fordingbridge. The main issue affecting sewage outflows is the high groundwater levels. This can fill sewage pipes leading them to overflow into the river. Again, there is a very high correlation with high rainfall, which not only leads to short term pollution events but also longer term as the groundwater struggles



to seep away.

Wessex Water's investment in the next 5 years will include:

- Sealing drains and sewers where they can
- Nature based solutions for the treatment plants (reed beds) which will clean the water more thoroughly before it goes into the river
- Storage to hold rainfall
- Continuous monitoring to better understand correlation and causations
- Phosphorus removal

A continuous monitoring probe has been installed at The George pub which will use AI to learn about river conditions, test the water and eventually become predictive of conditions and be able to give very accurate real time monitoring of pollution levels. This will help anyone using the river to make an informed decision about whether to enter the water or not.

Adam Ellis of FLOW CIC commented that it is 'inspiring to see so many people interested in the river's health'.





#### **Ringwood Rotary Club Schools Photographic Competition**

The presentation of certificates and winners' prizes for the Rotary Club of Ringwood Interschools Photographic Competition took place in The Barn, Ringwood School on 11th March 2025 Initiated in 2011 and organised jointly with Ringwood School, the competition has expanded to this year receiving over 900 entries from 35 schools invited across Hampshire, Dorset and Wiltshire. This year's theme was LAYERS.

Judging was carried out by a team drawn from the Rotary Club of Ringwood, Ringwood School Art Department, The Royal Photographic Society Digital Imaging Group, Ringwood Camera Club and the Arts University Bournemouth. A short list of some 50 images were selected within the four classes - Adult, Primary, Years 7-10 and Years 11-13.

The Winners in Student categories were, Emmeline Hall, St. Marks Junior School (Primary), Billy Dixon-Clarke, Trafalgar School (Y 7-10) and Freddie Serle, Ringwood School (Y 11-13).

In 2022, Rotarian Michael Lingam-Willgoss, a founder member of the competition team and a major fund raiser died. In his memory the award for the overall Best in Show, the MLW Prize for the Young Photographer of the Year, was presented to Billy Dickson-Clarke. The Arts University Bournemouth Prize went to Lily Cunningham-Davis King Edward 7th School (Y11-13) and was presented by Josh Read (Course Leader, Foundation Diploma in Art, Design and Media).

Mr. Max Cheshire, an alumnus of Ringwood School's Photographic Course, now an established Professional Photographer, was Guest Speaker.

The winning entries and the short-listed images will be on display at the Greyfriars Community Centre, Ringwood during the latter part of March



#### Understanding Investments-The importance of tax wrappers

Investments returns are primarily driven by investments markets, asset allocation and charges. Ensuring whoever is managing your investments are making sensible, well researched choices and are charging you a fair fee for doing so is job No1.

What many people don't understand is that the tax wrapper you then hold the investments in will also affect the financial outcome as tax can be a drag on performance. Therefore it's important that you own your investments in the optimal tax wrapper for your personal circumstances.

ISAs and Pensions are usually the first wrappers to consider as any growth within these are capital gains tax and income tax free. Pensions have more complex rules around contributions and withdrawals but for the purposes of this article the important thing to understand is that the underlying investment content of both ISAs and Pensions are tax free.

If a client has more money to invest then there are 3 main alternative wrappers; General Investment Account, Onshore Bond or Offshore Bond. What are the main features and considerations of each?

#### 1-General Investment Account (GIA):

Returns are subject to income tax and capital gains tax. Dividends are taxed at 8.75% and interest at 20% for basic rate tax-pavers but these increase to 33.75% and 40% for higher rate tax-payers and 39.35% and 45% for additional rate tax-payers. Capital gains tax is now at 18% or 24% (basic rate and higher/additional rate) and the annual capital gains tax exemption is £3,000.

The increase in the rate of capital gains tax and the reduction in the annual exemption means higher and additional rate tax-payers need to carefully consider whether a GIA is still the most suitable wrapper within which to hold their investments.

#### 2-Onshore Investment Bond:

The underlying investment growth is taxed as corporation tax equating to 20%. Interest is taxed at 20% and dividends are taxfree. Onshore Bonds are subject to the "chargeable event regime" which means that on surrender or death a tax event occurs which calculates the total return on the bond and any gains are subject

to income tax. However a 20% tax credit is applied. Depending on the bond-holder's tax position in the year of the event, there may be no further tax to pay or there may be a further 20% or 25% tax to pay on any growth of the investments. These bonds also allow up to 5% per annum of capital withdrawals for up to 20 years with no immediate tax charge.

Higher rate tax-payers now who will become basic rate tax-payers in retirement may be able to benefit from lower taxation on growth than a GIA but the key is mitigating a tax charge on exit which requires careful consideration.

#### 3-Offshore Investment Bond:

The underlying investment growth is tax free so these benefit from "gross roll-up". However they are also subject to the same "chargeable event regime" as Onshore Bonds and the same tax rules on surrender or exit but without the 20% tax credit. Therefore all returns are taxed at 20%, 40% or 45%.

It is important that there is an exit plan for these bonds. It is possible to assign segments of the bond (this is also possible with Onshore Bonds) so we often see these being assigned to a family member who is a none or basic rate tax-payer such as a grandchild to fund university fees or for a deposit for a house.

Tax rules are subject to change and are more detailed than a short-article can cover. Therefore it's important you take personal, financial advice before making any decisions on which wrapper works best for your circumstances.



# Ellingham & Ringwood RFC Ladies team



# Lessons for the Future, or a Warning from the Past?



In 1954, proposals to build a new town adjacent to Ringwood for a population of 40,000 people were made. Now, the story of how our town was nearly subsumed is to be recalled in a talk hosted by The Ringwood Society.

The talk, by Society member, Ken Chatfield examines the proposal by the London County Council, which was barely known about at the time and has since slipped further into obscurity. "I came across this story completely by chance whilst doing some family history research" Ken explains. "Immediately I was intrigued because, despite having a keen interest in local history, I had never

heard anything about it. That was enough to hook me in, and then as the story slowly emerged, I was struck by just what a 'nearmiss' it had been, and how it would have impacted almost everything about my entire lifetime experience of my home town." Ken's talk will cover how the scheme arose, what was planned and how it was stopped. Hightown resident; Major Colin Ziegler, was heavily involved in trying to stop the plans and this set him on the course of becoming the founding President of The Ringwood Society in 1962.

The talk will take place in the Ann Rose Hall at Greyfriars Community Centre at 7.30pm on 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2025, all are welcome.


# Charlie and The Chocolate Factory



# Fears for wildlife and further flooding if "absurd" house building plans go ahead on a New Forest floodplain.

Hundreds of people are asking New Forest District Council to reject a planning application for 140 new houses to be built on a local flood-plain, next to the protected Blashford Lakes Nature Reserve.

#### Blashford Wet Meadows' Location

The proposed site – locally known as **Blashford Wet Meadows** – is at Blashford, a small community of c.65 properties about one mile north of Ringwood. The Blashford Wet Meadows site is bordered by the River Avon to its west, Linbrook spate stream to its south, and the New Forest National Park, just a few hundred metres to its east.

The land is situated at the southern side of the ecologically-significant Blashford Lakes Nature Reserve (managed by Hampshire and Isle of Wight Wildlife Trust). Much of the area's 500 acres has protected status, with Sites of Special Scientific Interest and Special Areas of Conservation being just a few metres away from the proposed development land.

#### Importance of Blashford

The Blashford Lakes and Avon Valley area is internationally recognised as an important site for thousands of birds, mammals, reptiles and plants, and its importance is recognised by much of the area having protection status:

- i) SSSI Site of Special Scientific Interest
- ii) Ramsar Wetlands Convention
- iii) SPA Special Protection Area
- iv) SINC Site of Importance for Nature Conservation

The proposed development site at Blashford Wet Meadows borders these protections and, unsurprisingly, many of the Nature Reserve's species use Blashford Wet Meadows for nesting, breeding, feeding and/or roosting; the two are symbiotically linked.

Outside of the environmental and hydrological objections, other serious objections include:

- Lack of capacity at all the local schools and GP surgeries
- The generation of yet more traffic on the A338 and neighbouring Gorley Road, and the currently single track gravel lane being used as a 'rat run'.
- The impact on other local infrastructure and services, including the sewage treatment plant near Kingston which was declared "very close to capacity" five years ago.

A previous planning application was REJECTED by New Forest District Council in June 2021 because of extreme susceptibility to flooding. In the latest application, there are hundreds of documents to read through and, so far, the only flooding mitigation measures that have been found would potentially endanger the proposed development itself, local water courses, and neighbouring properties.

Clearly, the District Council needs to contribute towards the Government's target of building 1.5 million new homes within their five-year tenure but, as Chris Packham says, "Come on New Forest District Council ... can we have a rethink here?"



Brian was also a member of Fordingbridge Fire Station as a retained Fireman from 1974 to 1982. He experienced first-hand the incredibly hot and busy Summer of 1976 when Fordingbridge crews dealt with many forest fires across the area. This is still one of the busiest years for the fire service on record. At the end of 1976 Brian and the rest of the team at Fordingbridge Fire Station were personally thanked for all their hard work and efforts during a reception at the Ashburn Hotel hosted by Fordingbridge Parish Council.

In 2004 Brian again became part of another group of local volunteers supporting the Town. He joined the then newly formed

Community First Responders who provided initial assistance at medical emergencies prior to the arrival of an Ambulance. Brian carried out this role for several years.

#### Revival of Historic Church Clock to **Mark Milestone Anniversary**

The iconic church clock in Ringwood marketplace is in urgent need of restoration in time for its 250th anniversary next year, as well as the 800th anniversary of the market. The clock's original 1776 mechanism, a rare and valuable piece of history, remains in repairable condition, but it needs significant funding for restoration, this can be achieved through grant funding.

The clock's face, which was damaged by gales a few years ago, has been refurbished with a stainless-steel backing and newly re-gilded numerals, thanks to the skill of a rope access team and the expertise of the Cumbria Clock Company. While the clock's face has been restored, it has been powered for over 50 years by an electric mechanism, which became unreliable and now finally failed. The original clockwork movement remains in place in the tower.

Dating back to 1776, the clock's original mechanism is the largest of its kind in the country. With pagoda-shape frames, such clocks are incredibly rare, with only around 35 remaining nationwide, all built in the second half of the 18th century by a pair of clockmakers in Moorfields, London. Ringwood's was made by Charles Penton and stands as a remarkable piece of historical craftsmanship.

Last summer, Jonathan Betts, former Curator of Clocks at the National Maritime Museum, inspected the clock and confirmed that it is complete and even retains its original paint. The Cumbria Clock Company has provided a quote for its restoration, but £14,000 must be raised to make this historic repair possible. Unlike the electric clock, which would cost £6,000-7,000 to repair with no chance of grant funding, restoring the antique mechanism offers the potential for grants that could support the project.

The clock's restoration is not just about preserving history but ensuring it continues to serve as a symbol of the market's enduring legacy at the centre of the town. Local support and assistance with making grant applications and fundraising efforts would be invaluable. 


